Effective December 1, 2009**

6.2 (NEW)		New Rule 6.2 created that defines what constitutes inaccessibility of the Clerk's Office and how to handle an instance of inaccessibility.
7.3(c)	Clerk shall give 5 days notice of oral argument.	Changed 5 days to 7 days.
7.3(f)	Response to motion and brief due in 20 days after service of motion; 30 days if motion for summary judgment.	Changed 20 day deadline to 21 days.
7.3(g)	Court may grant extension of time to file 7.3(f) response; if good cause to grant the motion is not apparent upon the face of the motion, the Court may direct that the motion be served upon the opposing party, who shall be allowed 10 days to respond.	Changed 10 days to 14.
7.3(h)	Reply due in 10 days after service of response.	Changed 10 days to 14.
40.1(c)	Trial briefs along with jury instructions or findings of fact/conclusions of law shall be filed at least 20 days before trial.	Changed 20 days to 21.
54.1(b)(1)	Objections to bill of costs due within 10 days.	Changed 10 days to 14.
54.1(b)(2)	Responses to objections to bill of costs due within 5 days.	Changed 5 days to 7.

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54.1(e)	Within 20 days of receipt of costs, certificate of satisfaction must be filed.	Changed 20 days to 21.
56.1(a)	Notice of intention to file dispositive motions due within 10 days of discovery close.	Changed 10 days to 14.
56.1(d)	Reply brief for claimant's motion for summary judgment due within 10 days of service of the response.	Changed 10 days to 14.
56.1(e)	Reply brief for defending party's motion for summary judgment due within 10 days of service of the response.	Changed 10 days to 14.
83.9b(b)	If Court orders a mediation, parties have 20 days to select a mediator.	Changed 20 to 21 days.
83.9d(a)	Parties have 20 days from the initial pretrial order to select a mediator.	Changed 20 to 21 days.
83.9d(c)	A motion to disqualify a mediator is due at least 20 days in advance of the settlement conference.	Changed 20 to 21 days.
83.9e(c)	At least five days before settlement conference, parties may submit position papers.	Changed 5 business days to 7 days.
83.10c(b)	Response to order to show cause why identical attorney discipline should not be issued due within 20 days.	Changed 20 to 21 days.

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83.10c(c)	Unless adequate showing by respondent within 20 days of order to show cause, the Court will presume identical attorney discipline	Changed 20 to 21 days.
83.10f(c)	Counsel can request from the Court an attorney discipline show cause order giving 20 days to respond to order.	Changed 20 to 21 days.
83.10l(c)	Whenever it appears that an attorney disciplined by our court practices law in another jurisdiction, the Clerk of Court shall notify the other jurisdictions with 10 days.	Changed 10 to 14 days.
