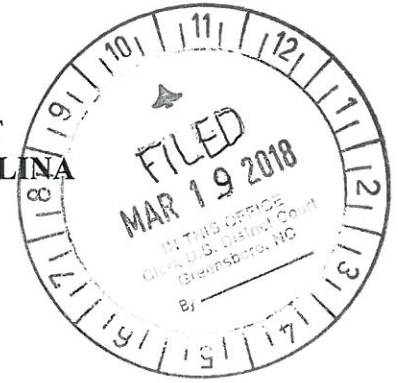

The Local Rules Committee for the Middle District of North Carolina proposed new or amended rules for Local Civil Rules 5.4, 83.9b, 83.9c, 83.9e and 83.9g. Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 83, this Court gave appropriate public notice and opportunity to comment. After review of the comments received, the Court found that all proposed changes should be approved.

The Court has taken notice that Local Civil Rule 105.2 contains a typographical error, and that the word “for” was omitted in the first sentence and should be corrected.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that all of the above referenced local rule changes are hereby approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall alert the public of this order through prominent display on the Court’s website and shall provide notice of the local rule amendments to this Court’s bar through the CM/ECF electronic noticing system.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall be effective April 1, 2018.




