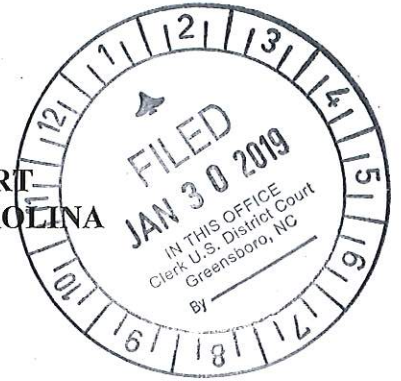

The Local Rules Committee for the Middle District of North Carolina proposed amendments to Local Civil Rule 5.3 regarding electronic filing and Local Civil Rule 54.1(c)(1) regarding taxation of costs of private process servers. Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 83, this Court gave appropriate public notice and opportunity to comment. After review of the comments received, the Court found that all proposed changes should be approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall be effective February 1, 2019.


