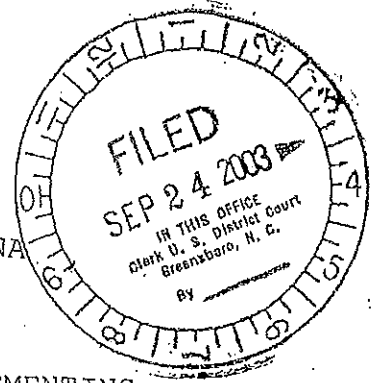

LCrR58.1

FORFEITURE OF COLLATERAL IN LIEU OF APPEARANCE

Pursuant to Rule 58, Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, and Local Criminal Rule 58.1, the following eight (8) schedules of collateral which may be posted and forfeited by a person charged with a petty offense in lieu of the appearance for trial of the offender are hereby established. All offenses not listed on the following eight (8) schedules require the mandatory appearance for trial of the offender.

Forfeiture of collateral in lieu of personal appearance for any listed offense is not permitted if:

- A. the violation is a felony; or
- B. the offense is aggravated; or
- C. the violation resulted in personal injury to anyone other than the violator; or
- D. multiple offenses arise out of the same facts or sequence of events; or
- E. a violation of an offense listed on one of the schedules herein was committed in connection with, or arose out of the same facts or sequence of events, as a violation


which is not listed herein; or


F. the offender wishes to enter a plea of not guilty.


Schedules A, B, and G attached hereto include or refer to offenses under North Carolina law which may be assimilated into federal law under the Assimilative Crimes Act (18 U.S.C. § 13) and for which forfeiture of collateral is permissible. All other violations of North Carolina law assimilated into federal law pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 13 require the mandatory appearance of the offender.


This Order is effective for all offenses listed which arise on or after the date this order is filed.
