- (a) **Orders and Judgments.** The clerk is authorized to grant the following orders and judgments without direction by the Court:
 - (1) Upon a showing of good cause, consent orders in civil actions for extending for not more than 30 days (plus an additional 30 days in exceptional circumstances) the time within which to answer or otherwise plead.
 - (2) Upon a showing of good cause, consent orders in social security administrative review cases for extending for not more than 30 days (plus an additional 30 days in exceptional circumstances) the time within which to file briefs and for extending for not more than 14 days (plus an additional 14 days in exceptional circumstances) the time to file reply briefs.
- (b) Clerk's Action Reviewable. The actions of the clerk may be suspended, altered, or rescinded by the Court upon cause shown.

Proposed

- (a) **Orders and Judgments.** The clerk is authorized to grant the orders and judgments on direction from the Court as specified by Standing Order 40 or other specific direction of the Court.
- (b) Clerk's Action Reviewable. The actions of the clerk may be suspended, altered, or rescinded by the Court upon cause shown.

Redline

- (a) **Orders and Judgments.** The clerk is authorized to grant the following orders and judgments without direction by the Court on direction from the Court as specified by Standing Order 40 or other specific direction of the Court.
- (b) Clerk's Action Reviewable. The actions of the clerk may be suspended, altered, or rescinded by the Court upon cause shown.
